Calvary Caller Devotional

One of the joys of being your pastor is to watch our confirmation students make connections between the events in the Bible Study and worship. Last night we studied the "Last Supper." We took turns reading the Mark 14:12-16, 22-26 and then Luke 22:14-23.

"Jesus broke it and gave it to them, saying, 'This is my body, which is given for you. Do this in remembrance of me.' And he did the same with the cup after supper, saying, 'This cup that is poured out for you is the new covenant in my blood.'" Salvation begins with FORGIVENESS, and forgiveness begins with Jesus giving His life for us, like the Passover Lamb. The eyes of our kids grew larger, and their hands shot up as they began to all recite the "Great Thanksgiving" from the worship liturgy. What a joy it was for me to see them connect the promise of the scripture to their worship experience!
