***Sunday, March 25—Palm/Passion Sunday  
Ti leaf Processional and Braiding***

*Music, Calvary Choir, "Jesus Is a Rock in a Weary Land," "Kyrie Eleison"*

Join the Calvary congregation in remembering Jesus' entry into Jerusalem as the congregation processes and places ti leaves on the cross. Throughout the worship service the ti leaves are braided into a lei to adorn the cross on Resurrection Sunday. In this Palm/Passion service we move from the triumphal entry to the passion narrative as Kahu Tim helps us understand that God's glory is the cross!

***Foot-washing, Holy Communion, Stripping of Altar***

With nightfall our Lenten observance comes to an end. Tonight we begin the Great Three Days—Maundy Thursday, Good Friday, and Vigil of Easter (Holy Saturday—the first Easter observance). At the heart of the Maundy Thursday liturgy is the New Commandment given by Jesus that we love one another. As Jesus washed his disciples’ feet, so we are called to follow his example as we care for one another. The service ends with the stripping of the altar. Everything is removed that identifies Calvary as a Christian sanctuary.

Tonight *Calvary by the Sea* joins the great and ancient tradition of the Vigil of Easter. This Holy Night service begins outside around the fire pit with the retelling of God’s mighty acts. Then we enter the sanctuary for the gospel and the first celebration of Jesus’ resurrection.
